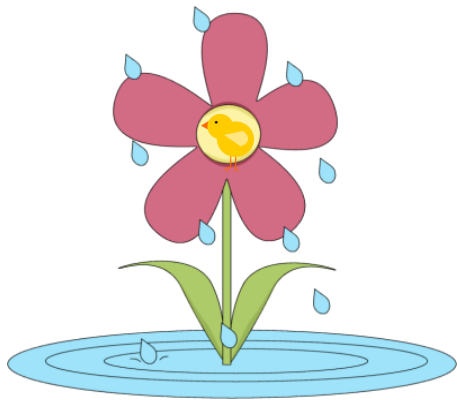

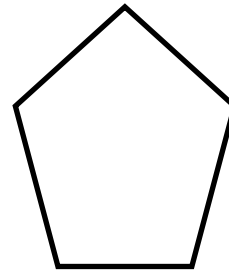

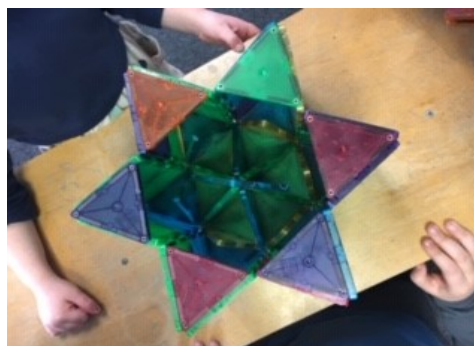


Twos:

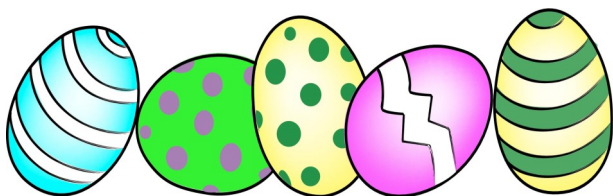
